
<u>Axis Monthly Bulletin</u> <u>Incidents for your attention</u>

There have been 3 serious stabbing incidents within Hillingdon (Ruislip, Hayes and Northwood) between March-April 2023 involving children aged 14-16 years old. AXIS encourage all partnerships to continue maintaining profressional curiosity and creating safe spaces to have discussions with children in regards to safety. A reminder that small pieces of information, help build a better understanding of risks in the community occuring within the borough.



There are currently 53 children actively engaging with AXIS Service at various stages as of March 2023. 60% (31) of the children identified were aged 15 years old and under. Males were majority identified at 69.1% compared to females are 30.4%. AXIS saw the rise of identifications of females at risk of exploitation and serious youth violence since 2022. AXIS continue to explore new and emerging trends, to better understand the risks in the community.
