


Axis Monthly Bulletin

Incidents for your attention

There have been 3 serious stabbing incidents within Hillingdon (Ruislip, Hayes and Northwood) between March-April 2023 involving children aged 14 -16 years old . AXIS encourage all partnerships to continue maintaining professional curiosity and creating safe spaces to have discussions with children in regards to safety. A reminder that small pieces of information , help build a better understanding of risks in the community occurring within the borough.

There are currently 53 children actively engaging with AXIS Service at various stages as of March 2023. 60% (31) of the children identified were aged 15 years old and under . Males were majority identified at 69.1% compared to females are 30.4% .


AXIS saw the rise of identifications of females at risk of exploitation and serious youth violence since 2022. AXIS continue to explore new and emerging trends , to better understand the risks in the community .
