

I have collected my 2023 GCSE results

I did not go to Rosedale College, Hewens College, Parkside Studio College or De Salis Studio College, and I want to enrol at The Rosedale Hewens Academy Trust for Sixth Form/Post 16.

Go to Rosedale College with your results slips for all your GCSE qualifications, your Year 11 school/college report and your passport.

Give these documents to Kellie or Elise at Reception, who will check that you meet both general entry and subject-specific requirements, and that your report demonstrates you to be a suitable student to study at the Trust.

I meet the general entry and subject-specific requirements

After checking your results slips, your report and your passport, Reception will give you a numbered ticket. This ticket will place you in the Enrolment Queue. You will be seen according to your number in the queue. You will have a short meeting to discuss your results, your chosen courses and your suitability. If successful, you will be given all necessary enrolment information during your meeting.

I meet the general entry requirements, but I don't meet the entry requirements for the subjects I want to study

Whilst you cannot enrol onto courses/subjects you do not meet the entry requirements for (no matter how close you were in marks), we can offer you suitable alternatives. We have a range of 29 subjects to choose from and can forge a pathway that is best for you, with appropriate qualifications. Collect a numbered ticket from Reception and wait for an enrolment meeting.

I do not meet the general entry requirements

Unfortunately, if you do not meet the Trust's published Post 16 general entry requirements, you will not be able to enrol and you will not be able to attend an enrolment meeting. It is important that you use your time wisely on GCSE Results Day, as spaces get filled up quickly. You should attend a school or college that have entry requirements matching what you achieved.
