

English Language Paper 2 Section B style tasks.

Here is a list of tasks that you might find in Section B of AQA English Language Paper 2. This section typically focuses on writing tasks where you are asked to express your viewpoint and develop an argument.

The tasks often ask you to write in various formats, such as letters, articles, speeches, or essays.

You have 45 minutes on the task. Spend a good 10 minutes responding to the statement, and planning your writing to meet the needs of your PAF – your purpose, audience and form. In other words, think very carefully about what you are writing, who you are writing it for, and why.

1. **Letter:** Write a letter to a local newspaper expressing your views on a current issue.
2. **Article:** Write an article for a school magazine on the impact of social media on teenagers.
3. **Speech:** Write a speech to be delivered at a school assembly on the importance of environmental conservation.
4. **Essay:** Write an essay discussing whether schools should start later in the day to benefit students' health and learning.
5. **Letter:** Write a letter to your MP arguing for or against a proposed change in local transport policies.
6. **Article:** Write an article for a national newspaper discussing the effects of fast food on public health.
7. **Speech:** Write a speech to be delivered at a community event about the significance of volunteering.
8. **Essay:** Write an essay exploring the pros and cons of online learning compared to traditional classroom education.
9. **Letter:** Write a letter to the headteacher of your school suggesting ways to improve the school environment.
10. **Article:** Write an article for a youth magazine on the challenges and rewards of balancing schoolwork with extracurricular activities.
11. **Speech:** Write a speech for a debate on whether technology is more harmful than beneficial to society.
12. **Essay:** Write an essay discussing the importance of maintaining a healthy work-life balance.
13. **Letter:** Write a letter to the local council addressing the issue of homelessness in your area and suggesting possible solutions.
14. **Article:** Write an article for a community newsletter about the benefits of participating in local sports teams.
15. **Speech:** Write a speech to be given at a public meeting about the impact of tourism on local communities.

These tasks assess your ability to argue, persuade, and present your viewpoint in a coherent and structured manner while using appropriate language and tone for the specified audience and purpose.
